



Drone Flying Policy

The operation of flying drones at the port of Peterhead must only be done in compliance with the Civil Aviation Authority ([CAA website](#)) requirements and the [Dronocode](#) which sets out the regulations in brief. This code confirms that drones with cameras must not be flown within a specified distance of people, vessels or structures and cannot be flown over congested areas.

In addition, Peterhead Port Authority must also be contacted and informed in advance of any activity involving drone flying.

Drone activity on a commercial basis requires the operator to be licensed by the CAA and Peterhead Port Authority must be provided with prior confirmation that a licence is held.
