



GUIDELINES ON ACCESS TO PETERHEAD FISH MARKET DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

SHORESIDE ACCESS

The access point to Peterhead Fish Market for Market Users is the main entrance.

This guidance shall apply to all users of the Fish Market (being all fishing vessel crew, salesmen, buyers, contractors, transporters, other workers, employees and all other persons entering Peterhead Fish Market, hereinafter referred to as "Market Users").

Entry Point Scanning - The Fish Market main entrance should be utilised by all shore side Market Users accessing the auction floor. Upon entry to Peterhead Fish Market all Market Users will have to pass through the thermal scanning equipment. The thermal scanning equipment will detect the Market Users core body temperature within 2 seconds, once an acceptable core temperature has been gained the equipment will open the gate and the market user can proceed through. Access to the Fish Market will be dependent on having a temperature lower than 37.8 °C. Any individual with a high temperature will be given an opportunity to isolate for 10 minutes and their temperature re-checked via the thermal scanner. If again the temperature is still greater than 37.8 °C they may request an additional temperature check which will be administered by a member of the Management team using a digital IR Thermometer. If the individual's core temperature is then below 37.8°C access will be granted to the Fish Market via the gate system. If a consistent temperature above 37.8°C is found then Government Guidelines should be followed.

ANY MARKET USER WITH A BODY TEMPERATURE OF 37.8°C OR ABOVE SHOULD FOLLOW GOVERNMENT GUIDELINES AND WILL NOT BE GRANTED ACCESS TO THE FISH MARKET.

Face Coverings - Wearing of a face covering is a mandatory legal requirement in all areas of the Peterhead Fish Market by all Market Users. Peterhead Fish Market provide face coverings for personnel that do not have their own personal covering. Any person who may be exempt from wearing a face covering will be asked to provide their name and company of employment to PPA staff when requested.

Exit from Peterhead Fish Market – Peterhead Fish Market operates a one-way system during and immediately following the fish sale in the morning. The first loading bay door at the Greenhill section is designated for this purpose. Entry to the Fish Market is not permitted through this door and only the main entrance should be utilised for this purpose.

The Fish Sale – The sales team will commence the sale at 0700 hrs, social distancing during the sale will be controlled by the salesperson at the point of sale. All Market Users that are part of that sale on the auction floor are requested to follow the salespersons guidance leading to during and following each sale.

Transport of Fish from The Fish Market - The transport and labour personnel accessing the auction room for the removal of fish will be granted access at 0800 hrs. The main entrance will be the only access point permissible.

Loading Bay Doors (Removal) - The loading bay doors will be opened for the removal of fish from Peterhead Fish Market. These doors are not to be used for the access or egress of personnel to and from the auction floor.

Loading Bay Doors (Input) - The loading bay doors will be opened by a market operative for the intake of fish, ice and pallets. Transport drivers wishing to access the auction floor must then utilise the main entrance for access and egress. Once the items have been unloaded the market operatives will then lock the doors.

Fire Doors - Fire doors are for emergency use only.

ANY MARKET USER WHO BYPASSES THE CONTROL MEASURES IN PLACE OR USES AN UNDESIGNATED ENTRANCE TO PETERHEAD FISH MARKET WILL BE HELD ACCOUNTABLE AND FACE DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURES UNDER THE FISH MARKET RULES AND REGULATIONS.

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
